ADOPTION TERMS

Upon signing an adoption contract, these terms and conditions will be submitted to the adopter for approval. By signing the contract, the adopter agrees to the terms and conditions below.

1. As an adopter, you promise to give the animal a good and loving home.
2. You will ensure that the animal receives all necessary medical care, proper nutrition as well as annual vaccinations, defleaing, and deworming (at least twice a year) that are necessary for the well-being of the animal and its environment. Kittens should be dewormed more frequently. Ask the foster family for the medical schedule for this.
3. NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven provides the cats with two vaccinations against cat- and sneezing disease (at 8 and 12 weeks for kittens). Medical studies show however that for kittens a third vaccination is recommended at the age of 16 weeks. The adopter chooses whether this third vaccination is given and takes responsibility for this. The non-profit organization is not responsible for the cost of this third vaccine since it is not mandatory.
4. You keep the adopted cat inside for at least 8 weeks to let the animal get used to his/her new environment. For kittens, we advise keeping them inside until the age of 6 months.
5. NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven is not liable for medical costs or any other costs whatsoever which are made after the animal is transferred to the adopter. If within 10 days after the adoption of the animal medical problems arise, NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven must be informed immediately and in consultation with NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven and its regular veterinarian an arrangement can be proposed.
6. If, at any moment, it is decided not to keep the animal any longer the adopter has to immediately bring the animal back to NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven. The adopter has to communicate the reason for the decision. Under no circumstances may the animal be passed on to a third party or to another animal shelter under penalty of payment of compensation. However, the paid adoption fee cannot be recovered.
7. The adopter shall immediately inform NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven via mail info@StrayCatinleuven.be with each change of address, telephone or e-mail. So that the new data can be quickly adjusted in the administration and the adopter, if desired, can continue to be kept informed of news from the non-profit organization.

NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven only keeps the data they receive from you when concluding an adoption contract with NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven (name and address, contact details, national register number). This data is stored in Google Drive and on paper at the board of the non-profit organization. In addition, this data is also stored in specialized software for shelters, ShelterLuv, and in AnimalShelter, the system of the Flemish Government. On the basis of this data, it is possible for us to keep in touch with you regarding the cat's well-being, if necessary to have the chip adjusted with your data, and to contact you when your missing cat is found. This information is kept until the death of the cat is reported or up to 20 years after the adoption of the cat. NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven does not give data to third parties. If you want to look into your data, correct it or withdraw it, you can always send an e-mail to info@StrayCatinleuven.be. Stray Cat in Le(u)ven declares to respect the European Regulation 2016/679 concerning the protection of personal data.

8. The adoption fee is a contribution to the general costs of the non-profit organization. Our costs for each sheltered animal are unfortunately higher than the contribution. The adoption contribution includes the implantation and registration of the chip, defleaing and deworming, 2 vaccinations (against sneezing and Feline Panleukopenia), and the sterilization/castration.
9. NPO Stray Cat in Le(u)ven has the right to evaluate 1 month and 6 months after signing the adoption contract whether it is complied with. If violations are found, the non-profit organization has the right to confiscate the cat(s) without any compensation for the adopter.
